

Case of a Cat's Head Injury

“Cuddles” was a 2-year-old spayed, healthy female cat who had fallen from the top of a two-story garage; her fall had been stopped by a series of bushes that lined the side of the garage. She presented with unfocussed eyes, lethargy and a low meow (symbolized crying in a cat).

After a thorough examination revealed no obvious internal injuries or broken bones (surprisingly), the homeopathic Arnica Montana 200C was administered. Within 5 minutes, the cat's eyes refocused and she stopped crying. She lay quietly cleaning her fur.

Outcome: The homeopathic was repeated again the following day. There was no further evidence of trauma from the fall. It was also recommended that Cuddles not go onto the roof of high places again.
